Fuel Mag

We recently installed a Fuel Mag to the fishing vessel "Miss Snolyne". The Fuel Mag was located between the fuel tank and Racor filter. The main engine is a 12V-71.

The following problems were being encountered;

- Suspected "fuel-bug"
- Premature plugging of fuel filters
- Rust contamination from steel fuel tanks
- Engine smoking

Within 3 days the Skipper has reported these favourable results;

- Engine smoke has been reduced
- The Racor filter is still clean
- The Fuel Mag has collected small particles of rust/metal before the filters
- Engine oil consumption has been decreased from 3 litres per day to 1.5 litres per day

I can not understand why the oil consumption has decreased - perhaps resulting from more complete combustion now.

We are delighted with the results achieved by the installation of the Fuel Mag on the "Miss Snolyne".
